The mother of John and Charles Wesley was Susannah Wesley. She had 19 children and listed below are the rules for her children:

1. Allow no eating between meals
2. Put all children in bed by 8pm
3. Require them to take medicine without complaining
4. Subdue self-will in a child and thus work with God to save his soul
5. Teach each one to pray as soon as he can speak
6. Require them to be still during family worship
7. Never let a sinful act go unpunished
8. To prevent lying, punish no fault which is first confessed and repented of
9. Never punish a child twice for a single offense
10. Commend and reward good behavior
11. Any attempt to please, even if poorly performed, should be commended
12. Strictly observe all promises
13. Give them nothing that they cry for, and only that which they ask for politely
14. Teach children to fear the rod
15. Preserve property rights, even in the smallest matters
16. Require no daughter to work before she can read well

Each of us needs some guidelines for raising children. Some might disagree with some of these, but they worked pretty well in John and Charles' case.
